Basic Benefits of starting a local ClubGP chapter

- ◆ Your club will be provided web space on the **ClubGP** web site, and additional web resources.
- ◆ You will be provided the ability to add or remove local club members from your club registry on the **ClubGP** online database.
- ◆ Your club will be provided a mailing list for online email correspondence on the **ClubGP** supported servers.
